VRQ for Domestic Installers – Part P (EL5) 5 days

This qualification was developed in partnership with the Electrical Contractors Association (ECA), National Inspection Council for Electrical Installation Contracting (NICEIC), Corgi and SummitSkills. The qualification has been developed to comply with the requirements of Part P of the Building Regulations introduced by the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister (ODPM).

City & Guilds 2382-10 17th Edition (EL2) 3 days

This workshop is aimed at practising electricians, electrical contractors and those who require good working knowledge of BS 7671:2008 (IEE Wiring Regulations, 17th Edition).

City & Guilds 2391 Testing & Inspection (EL8) 3 Days plus half day practical and evening examination

This workshop covers the requirements of BS7671 for inspection, testing, certification and guidance given in IEE guidance note 3, Inspection & Testing; practical demonstrations and hands on sessions; preparation for the practical assessment of up to 4 hours duration; written examination (closed book) in two sections comprising of short answer and structured questions.
